North Florida Land Trust (NFLT) is a not-for-profit organization working to preserve and enhance our quality of life by protecting North Florida's irreplaceable natural environment. Since its founding in 1999, NFLT has protected more than 26,000 acres of unique landscapes and ecosystems that provide habitat for wildlife, clean air and water, and support the quality of life for residents of North Florida. We work closely with public agency partners, private landowners, foundations, and other land trusts to ensure that the land we save today remains protected forever.

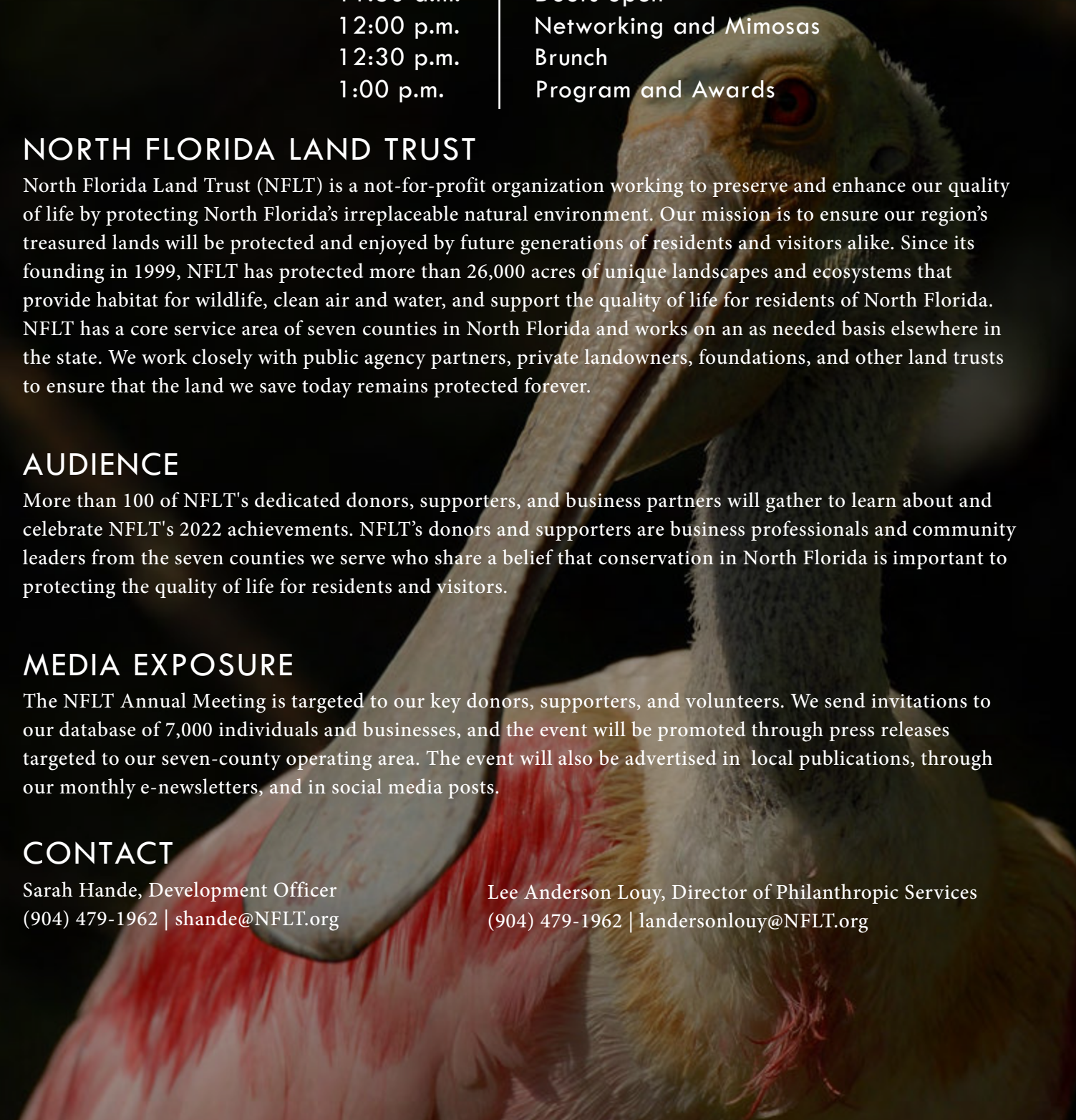
MEDIA EXPOSURE
